

INSTRUCTION SHEET

RENUNCIATION

1. The attached Renunciation form should be read carefully before it is completed.
2. The form must be completed in duplicate and signed before a Justice of the Peace, Commissioner of Affidavits, Notary Public or an Official of similar standing.
3. Evidence of the applicant's place and date of birth must be submitted, i.e. certified copy of birth certificate. In the case where the applicant is a Grenadian Citizen under Section 97, i.e. born outside of Grenada after 7th February, 1974, evidence of the parent's place and date of birth must be submitted, i.e. a certified copy of the parent's Birth Certificate. If no name appears on the Birth Certificate in either case, a certified copy of the Baptismal Certificate or Original Affidavit must be submitted.
4. In the case of a married woman, a certified copy of the Marriage Certificate must be submitted.
5. Two (2) passport size photographs (50mm×50mm) of the applicant **CERTIFIED** by a Justice of the Peace or Notary Public: "I certify that this is a true likeness of....."
6. Grenadian passport in your possession
7. EC \$250.00 (equivalent to US\$.....) must be submitted in a Bank Draft (including EC \$5.10/ US \$..... banking transaction fee) or Money Order or British Postal Order made payable to the **Government of Grenada**.
