Results from the 2013 Secondary Schools' Drug Prevalence Survey in Grenada showed that (40%) of students reported that they obtained alcoholic beverages from friends and 20% of the respondents indicated that they obtained it from shops. Eleven percent (11%) of females reported accessing alcohol more from other relatives. Males reported having obtained alcohol more from street vendors (13% vs. 5%) and from shops (24% vs. 16%) when compared to females.

Figure 1. Summary of Where/ From Whom Students Accessed Alcoholic Beverages

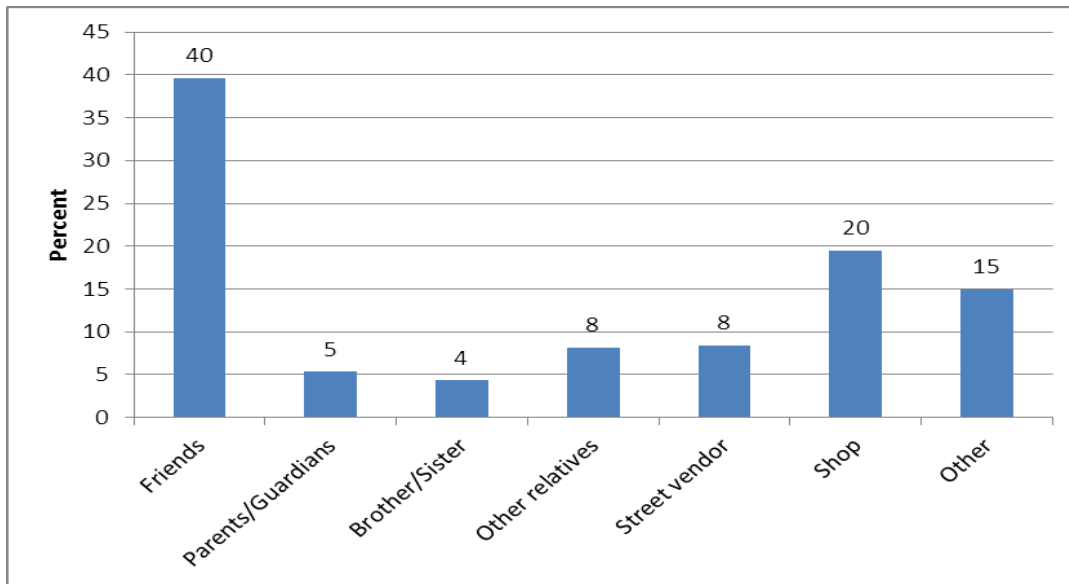


Figure 2. Summary of Where/ From Whom Students Accessed Alcoholic Beverages by Gender
