The information presented below provide a description of the nationalities of persons arrested and charged in Grenada for drug related offences during the period 1 January to 31 December, 2015. A total of four hundred and fourteen (414) persons were arrested and charged. 89% of the persons arrested were Grenadian nationals comprising of three hundred and forty five (345) males and twenty four (24) females. Among the other nationalities were twenty seven (27) Guyanese nationals; all males and eight (8) Vincentian nationals, comprising of six (6) males and two (2) females.

Statistics also show that between 2011 and 2016, 3,495 Grenadians were arrested and charged for drug-related offences (3,298 males and 197 females).
