



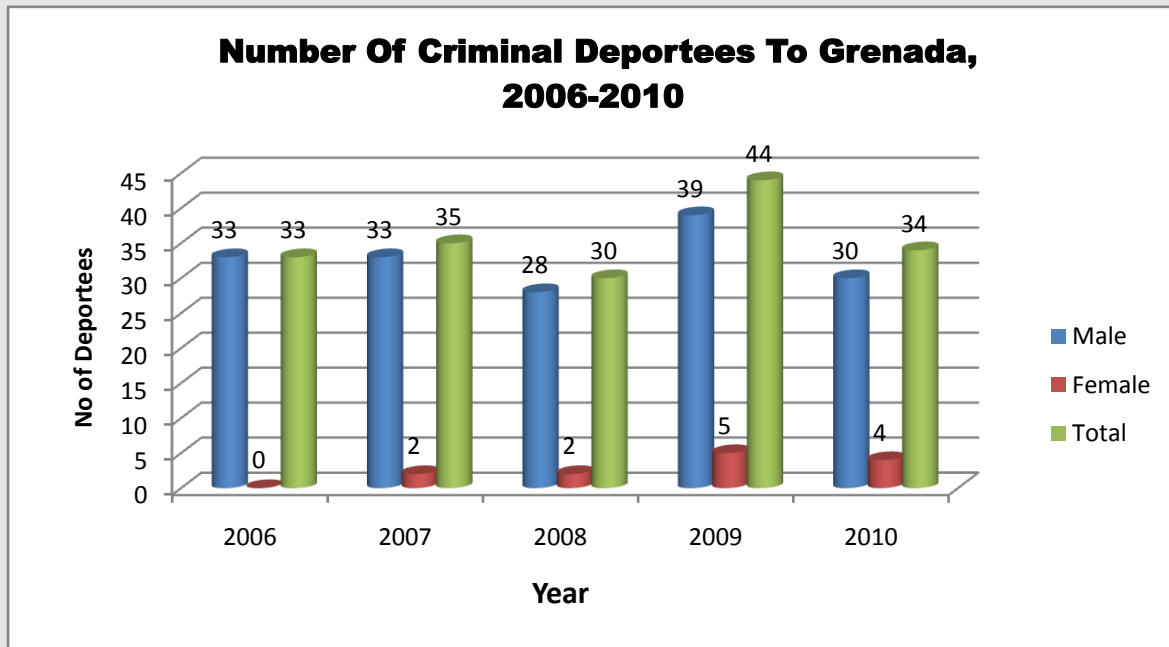
GRENDIN FACT SHEET

An analysis of the Grenada Drug Information Network (GRENDIN) data 2006-2010, revealed that **one hundred and seventy-six (176)** persons were deported to Grenada for criminal offences. These criminal deportees comprised of **one hundred and sixty three (163)** males and **thirteen (13)** females. The chart below summarizes the number of deportees by year and gender.

The main countries from which they were deported:

- ✚ United States of America
- ✚ Canada
- ✚ Britain

Major offences committed by the criminal deportees which resulted in the incarceration and subsequent deportation:

- ✚ Drug-related
- ✚ Robbery
- ✚ Possession of weapons
- ✚ Fraud

The Grenada Drug Information Network (**GRENDIN**) is the mechanism through which the Government of Grenada coordinates the collection, analysis and dissemination of statistical information on controlled drugs and related information. It was established in December 2002.
