The Governments of Dominica, Grenada, Saint Lucia and St. Vincent and the Grenadines have each received individual credits in the amount of 1.5 Million SDRs, equivalent to US\$ 2.3 Million, from the International Development Association (IDA) for the financing of the OECS Electronic Government for Regional Integration Project (EGRIP) and intend to apply part of the proceeds for consultancy services for a **Assessment and Conceptual design of a regional Health management information system**

The Regional E-Government Unit (REGU) of the OECS Secretariat now invites eligible consulting firms to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications.

The key objectives of this assignment include:

- (i) To determine the requirements for the Regional Health Management Information System (HMIS);
- (ii) To assess the current and proposed systems that exist in the Participating Countries; and
- (iii) To deliver a conceptual and detailed technical design of a health management information system for the region.

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers, January 1997 (revised September 1997, January 1999, May 2004 and October 2006).
