Saint Vincent and the Grenadines has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Human Development Service Delivery Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include assisting the Focal Point for the Ministry of National Mobilisation, etc. with the day-to-day coordination, management and implementation of the social protection activities of the Human Development Service Delivery Project. The Consultant is required to have an undergraduate degree in Social Protection, Project Management or other relevant field and at least five years experience in project management in a social protection environment. The expected start date of the consultancy is October 15th, 2017 and will be a full-time assignment for two years in the first instance, subject to renewal based on satisfactory performance.
