## Request for Expressions of Interest

The Government of Grenada (GOG) and the Government of Saint Lucia (GOSL) have received financing from the World Bank (International Development Association) towards the cost of the OECS Skills for Inclusive Growth Projects, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consultant services. The services include development and implementation of MIS on the .NET framework platform as a web-based system with back end database utilizing MS SQL Servers 2005/2008, and Business Intelligence with Reporting Services. The system will be developed in ASP.NET MVC using either VB.NET or C Sharp .NET languages based on the layered approach to system architecture (Specifications of the IT framework are also included in the RFP document) to support the information needs of project beneficiaries [MOE, NSDC, NTA, PCU and all other relevant stakeholders]. The components and time frame for delivery of the assignment are the following:

Phase 1	Analysis and Detailed Design (7 weeks)
Phase 2	Development (14 weeks)
Phase 3	Training (2 weeks)
Phase 4	Deployment (2 week)
Phase 6	Maintenance and Support (6 months) followed by six months after sales service

The Consultancy for development, implementing, training, testing and deploying of the software should be for a duration of six (6) months and an additional warranty/maintenance/support period of six (6) months.

The Government of Grenada and the Government of Saint Lucia through the Ministry of Education in both countries now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications.
