CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR: CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

The Government of Grenada (GOGR) received financing from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) towards the cost of Awakening Special Potential by Investing in Restoration and Empowerment (ASPIRE), Youth Project and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this financing to eligible payments under a contract for which this invitation is issued. Payments by CDB will be made only at the request of GOGR and upon approval by CDB and will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the Financing Agreement. The Financing Agreement prohibits withdrawal from the financing account for any payment to individuals or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than GOGR shall derive any rights from the Financing Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Financing.

The Ministry of Social Development and Housing, the Executing Agency, now wishes to procure consultancy services for a Clinical Psychologist, on a part-time basis consultancy basis.

The objective of the consultancy is to provide clinical psychological support to the Grand Bacolet Juvenile Rehabilitation Treatment Centre (GBJRTC). More specifically, the Consultant will undertake to do the following:

- (a) Provide technical support to the Treatment team of the GBJRTC, in the area of treatment planning
- (b) Conduct psychological assessment of referred cases
- (c) Provide expert psychological services to the Courts and the GBJRTC
- (d) Provide psychological administrative support for GBJRTC
- (e) Provide expert advice in case conferences
- (f) Provide didactic training for the staff of the GBJRTC
- (g) Provide clinical support and guidance to the Counselor of Projects ACE and REACH
- (h) Practical experience in conducting psychological assessments such as Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children (WISC-V), Minnesota Multiphasic Inventory (MMPI-2), BECK Youth Inventory (BYI-2), Childhood Trauma Questionnaire (CTQ)

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

The Consultant will report to the Manager of the GBJRTC and shall deliver the following:

- (a) Minimum of three (3) Psychological Assessment and reports weekly
- (b) Debriefing meetings with Treatment team once fortnightly
- (c) Provision of expert advice to the Court and Treatment Team on a monthly basis as requested
- (d) Review and audit of all files bi-annually

- (e) Minimum of two (2) training workshops and presentations, for staff and key stakeholders, per year
- (f) Provision of quarterly reports to the Manager in accordance with the standards of the American Psychological Association. All reports must provide statistics on cases

QUALIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE

The Consultant must possess the following qualification and experience:

- (a) A PHD in Clinical Psychology
- (b) Practical experience in conducting psychological assessment, treatment planning, provision of training etc.
- (c) Experience working with children and youth
- (d) Knowledge of Juvenile Justice Issues

DURATION

The assignment is expected to be for a period of thirty-six (36) months, on a part-time basis.

HOW TO APPLY

The Ministry of Social Development and Housing, now invites interested eligible individual consultants to submit Expressions of Interest (EOI) indicating qualifications and experience required to provide the consultancy service.

Consultants shall be eligible to participate if:

- (a) the persons are citizens or *bona fide* residents of an eligible member country of the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB); and
- (b) in all cases, the consultant has no arrangement and undertakes not to make any arrangements, whereby any substantial part of the net profits or other tangible benefits of the contract will accrue or be paid to a person not a citizen or *bona fide* resident of an eligible country.
