**Assignment Title: Supervision for the Construction of Dennery Polyclinic**

Saint Lucia has received financing from the World Bank towards the Disaster Vulnerability Reduction Project (DVRP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services for Supervision for the Construction of Dennery Polyclinic.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include providing pre-construction, construction and post-construction services, to ensure compliance of the executed works to the contract documents, to certify works, and to review the quality of the executed works thereby ensuring that the new polyclinic is constructed to deliver effective health care services to clients in Dennery and environ communities. Thus, ensuring that the facility can withstand prospective hazards such as storms, earthquakes, hurricanes and floods.

The Department of Economic Development, Transport and Civil Aviation now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services; (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, *(please note that the individual experts’ bio data is not required.)*)

**The shortlisting criteria are:**

**The minimum required qualifications and experience of the consulting firm are:**

At least ten (10) years of experience in supervision of civil works contracts.

**Similar Experience:**

At least two (2) successfully completed contract during the past five years for supervision of construction of civil engineering structures such as a two (2) story reinforced concrete public buildings and other complex concrete type structures.

To be qualified, the Consulting Firm shall propose a team of key experts with the following qualifications and experience:

Clerk of Works	Associate Degree/Diploma in Civil & Structural/ Building Engineering/Construction	At least seven (7) years working experience in the related discipline.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers* ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications. **The associations should clearly indicate the form of the association (Joint-venture or sub-consultancy; member in charge; other member/s and or sub-consultants). Joint ventures shall submit letters of intent**

**indicating their intent to form a joint venture if awarded the contract and shall provide the above mentioned information for each member of the joint venture.**

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Least Cost Selection (LCS) method set out in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers* ("Consultant Guidelines").
