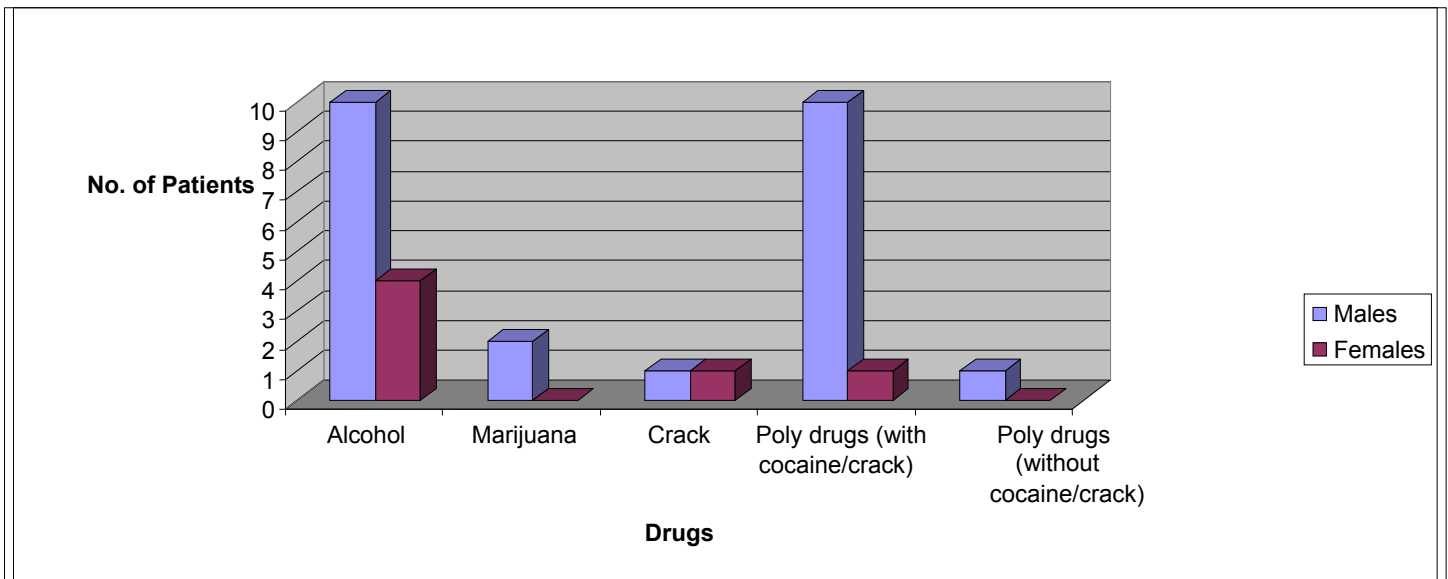

According to the **GRENDAIN** Statistical Report of Indicators for the period *1 January to 31 December 2008*, thirty (30) persons were admitted to the **Carlton House Treatment and Rehabilitation Center**; **twenty four (24)** males and **six (6)** females. This center, which was established in 1985, offers services to persons who experience drug related problems. Presently, Carlton House provides limited out-patient services for about five (5) hours per day. The following table and graph present information on admissions to Carlton House for the period *1 January to 31 December 2008*.
