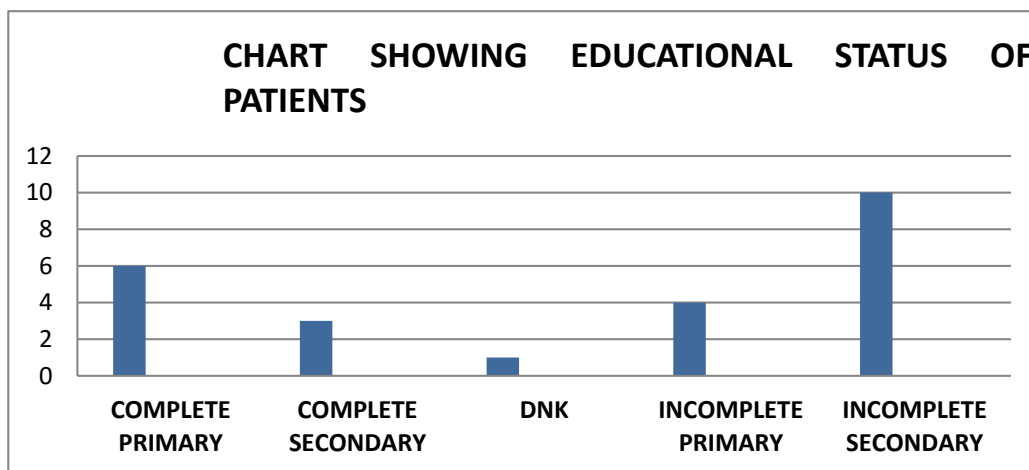




GRENDEN FACT SHEET

The table and chart below provide a brief analysis of the educational status of twenty four (24) patients who were admitted to the Rathdune Psychiatric Unit and the Carlton House Treatment Center, during the period 1 January to 30 June 2015, for problems associated with the consumption of drugs and alcohol. The data was collected by the Grenada Drug Epidemiology Network (GRENDEN) using the Inter-American Drug Abuse Control Commission (CICAD) Standard Drug Treatment Intake Form.
