



Data obtained from the Grenada Drug Epidemiology Network (GRENDEN), Indicators on criminal deportees, indicate that eighty-eight (88) persons deemed to be 'restricted persons', (often referred to a criminal deportees) were deported to Grenada, between 2014 and 2018. According to the data, eighty-three (83) of the criminal deportees were males, and five (5) were females.

Chart 1 below shows the number of criminal deportees per year, for the period 2014 to 2018.

**CHART 1: Criminal Deportees to Grenada, 2014 to 2018**

Meanwhile, forty-three (43) percent of the deportees, which represent thirty-eight persons, were deported from the United States of America. Twenty-three (23) percent, or twenty (20) persons, were sent from Canada.

Chart 2 below presents statistics on the countries of deportation.

According to the Deportees Registration Act of 2003, a person is designated as a 'restricted person' any citizen of Grenada, who is the subject of a deportation order made in the foreign state or who has elected to return to Grenada from that state in lieu of deportation. (Deportees Registration Act, Section 3)
