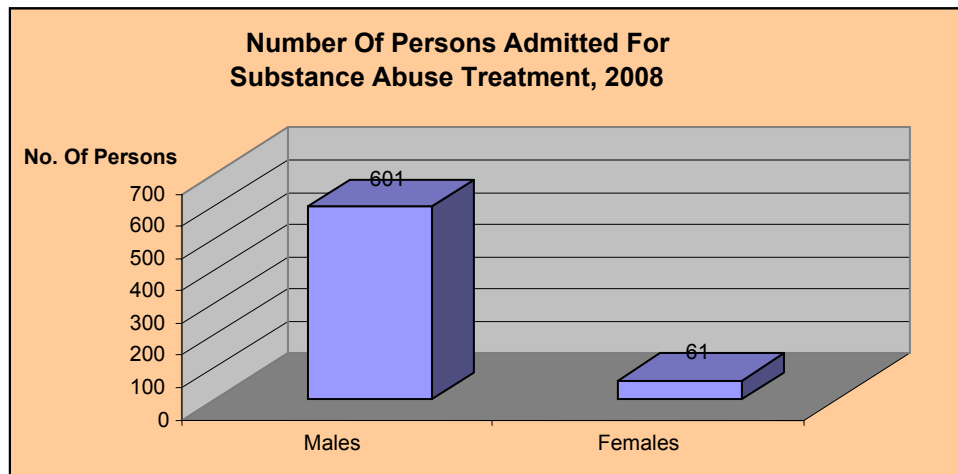
The Grenada Drug Information network (GRENDAIN) Statistical Report of Indicators for the period **1 January to 31 December 2008** has revealed that six hundred and sixty-two (662) persons were admitted to the Grenada's three treatment facilities, for problems associated with substance abuse.

The table and graph which follow, present information on the **drugs which motivated the treatment** and the number of males and females admitted to these centers.
